WHAT WE HAVE FOR YOU ...

A world-class library!

Print:

The University of Michigan Dentistry Library has one of the most comprehensive dental collections in the world, with close to 70,000 volumes. The Library holds over 700 periodical titles and includes virtually every dental journal published in English, as well as selected foreign language titles.

Electronic:

Over 6,000 fulltext electronic journals and books are available through the University Libraries. The Dentistry Library offers ~300 electronic dental journals and rare and historic materials that have been made available electronically to the world.

Databases:

The most-used database is Medline (both as part of UM-MEDSEARCH and with a special UM version of PubMed). Other popular databases for our dental community are Cochrane; Scopus; and WebOfScience (including Journal Citation Reports and impact factors). Hundreds of other databases are made available via SearchTools.

WHAT WE DO FOR YOU ...

Circulation & Borrowing (764-1526):

UM faculty, staff and students may borrow materials from the library using their M-Card.

Get Books and Articles:

- library-to-library delivery
- interlibrary loan
- articles as PDFs or photocopies via PullAndCopy service or 7-FAST for \$3.75 an article.

Course Reserves:

Faculty may place materials for their classes on reserve in the Library. Books may be checked out for a limited time, and articles are usually made available online.

Database & Literature Searches:

Professional librarians will conduct an expert search of the literature (based on an hourly fee).

Proxy Borrowing:

Designate a person to borrow library materials on your behalf for research or when you are traveling, or anytime! Ask for a form at the Circulation Desk, or check our website for a PDF version.
