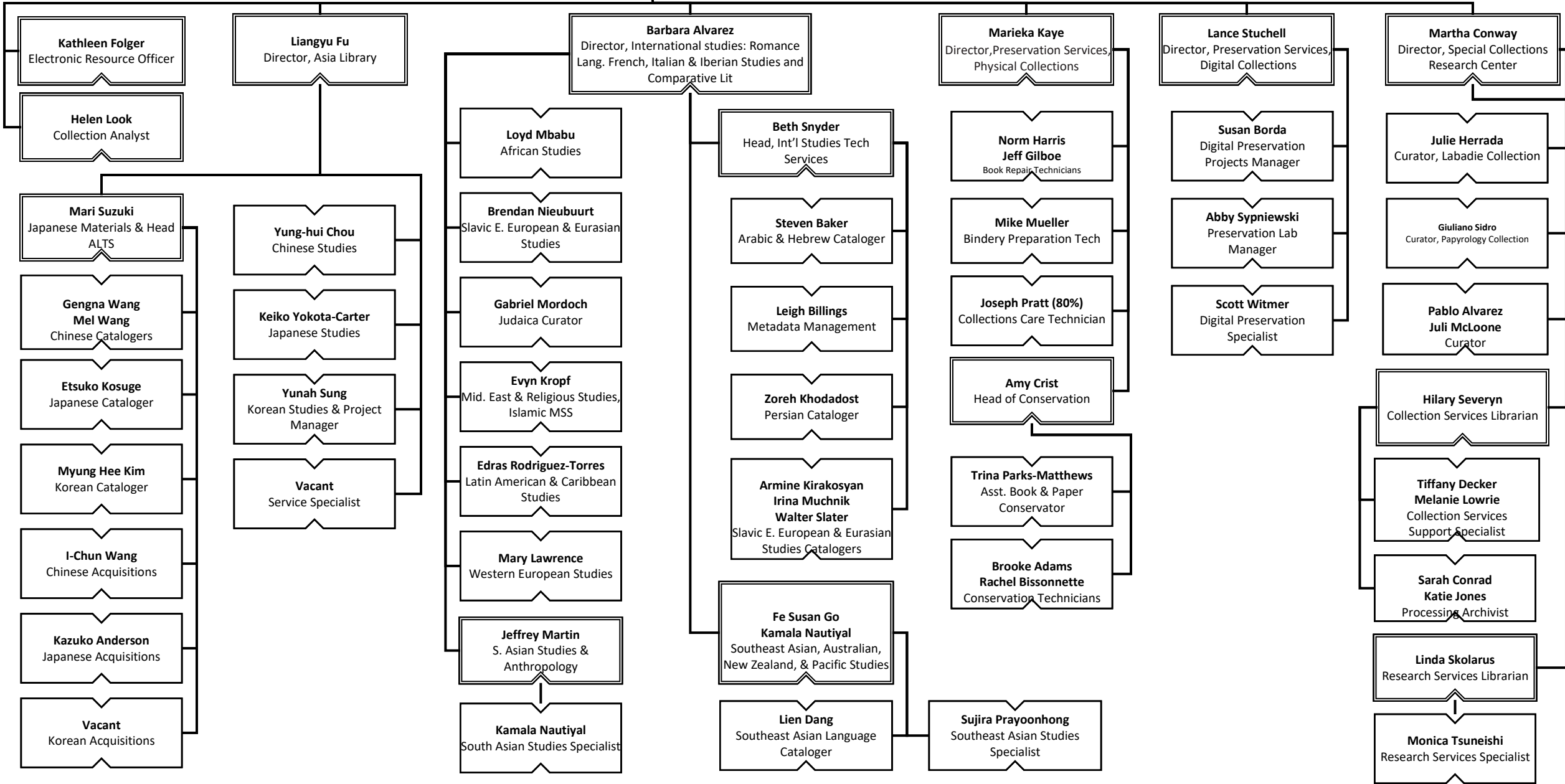
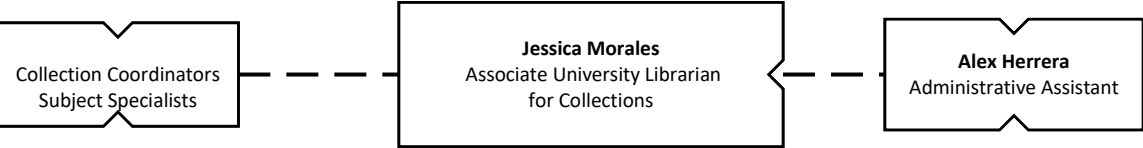

Overview
